



The HAF Tool Library



HAF is excited to announce its newest advocacy effort: A Tool Library – expected launch in May or June of 2022.

Libraries of things have been growing in popularity as an antidote to waste, the excess of consumerism, and the issue of ongoing inequality. For a minimal annual fee, all members will be able to borrow and return items as and when need them. Tools are often expensive, and for many do not represent a meaningful investment, in that they may only

be used a handful of times, are for one project, or are only used at certain times of the year. The Tool Library will not only promote a sharing economy but will also empower the residents of the Capital Region by showing them how to use the tools as well.

In short, our aim for the Tool Library will accomplish:

- > Democratize tools to make preservation more accessible to all
- > Empower individuals by teaching skills
- > Create an active sharing economy and community
- > Help the environment
- > Help to prevent deferred maintenance to properties, which can lead to vacancy

By sponsoring the Tool Library, HAF can purchase tools and the infrastructure to organize them, create and provide How To, DIY and safety trainings and workshops, create materials and advertising to promote the Tool Library to the residents of Albany's neighborhoods who need this service the most, as well as provide training to the team of volunteers who will operate the Tool Library.

Restoration Faire 2022

Saturday, May 21, 2022

Corner of Sheridan and Lexington Avenues

The Restoration Faire is an annual program hosted by Historic Albany to provide assistance to property owners looking to purchase and restore historic buildings in the City of Albany. This year, as part of our overall Reimagining Lexington Avenue advocacy theme, the Faire will be held on a vacant lot on Lexington Avenue.

The event hosts in person and online programming including webinars, Q & As, a dedicated Facebook group for networking, etc. The in person programming will include lectures, demonstrations by seasoned contractors, clinics with our speakers, and open houses with the Albany County Land Bank. Vendors will be invited to participate in addition to the workshops and learning sessions.



The Faire traditionally focuses on four different topics: vacancy and foreclosure prevention, getting started on a restoration project, in progress pitfalls and help, finishes and decor. Previous programs on permitting, funding, and neighborhood resources will be made available again.

This program is a partnership between Historic Albany Foundation, the City of Albany, and the Albany County Land Bank.

Historic Walking and Bike Tours Spring, Summer and Fall 2022



Each year, Historic Albany Foundation hosts a series of walking and bike tours that explore various Albany locations and neighborhoods. Past tours have included the Mansion and Washington Avenue Neighborhoods, Marcus Reynolds' State Street, the Tudors, the mid-Century modern homes near Buckingham Pond, Hamilton in Albany, Center Square, the downtown UAlbany Campus, and to name a few.

Each tour is directed by a local historian, volunteer or HAF staff member with specific knowledge of the location and sites. These popular walking tours are generally attended by up to 35 locals and tourists. An average of at least 30 tours take place each year through the

spring, summer and fall.

The barn is surrounded by beautiful grounds, fields, a bridge, a garden, and other historic buildings. The size, style, and location of the barn make it extremely unique to our area and being surrounded by farm-like grounds makes it stand apart.

All of the proceeds from the event support the mission and goals of Historic Albany Foundation, to promote the preservation and appreciation of the built environment.

Historic Albany Foundation, Center Square Association and the Hudson/Park Neighborhood Association join together each year to present one of the most enduring events of the summer, garnering up to 800 guests! This unique glimpse into our City's historic urban homes and gardens is a highly anticipated annual event for history, garden and architecture lovers alike.

Tour attendees have access to walk through an average of 10 homes and gardens, as well as other neighborhood attractions, such as churches and special renovation projects.

The day will feature access to private gardens throughout the downtown Albany neighborhoods in addition to:

public over the long weekend.

This year we are again thrilled to be partnering with the historic Argus Hotel on Thurlow Terrace in Albany. Once a private residence, then used as offices, the Argus Hotel has been lovingly restored to its former elegance and serves as a 12 room boutique hotel.

HAF is proud to demonstrate our mission through this annual art exhibition and silent auction of regional artist's work. The theme for the artwork each year is the Capital Region's built environment. This annual juried exhibition and sale brings together many art mediums from some of the region's best known artists and includes up to 175 unique artworks of photography, paintings, drawings, and sculpture, as well as items made from salvaged materials.
